Exam Requirement

Purpose

Objective assessment of knowledge and practice across wide spectrum of conditions treated by family physicians.

Exam Options

- → Longitudinal Assessment
- → One-Day Exam





How Does Longitudinal Assessment Work?

Begin in January of next exam year

Complete 300 questions over 3-4 years

Immediate feedback and critiques

5 minutes allowed per question

If needed, take the one-day exam in year 5





Diplomate Feedback Last 5 Years

33,587 - Participated 82% - Chose FMCLA 98%+ - Retention Rate 92% - Report Less Test Anxiety

99% - Relevant to Family Medicine 94% - Relevant to Current

96% - Use References & Critiques 85% - Sought More Information After Exam

 80-100 articles available per year. Read as many as you want.
- Answer four questions per article to receive CME and certification points.
- Growing rapidly with 27,000 Diplomates participating.

Losing Certification is Uncommon

- 0.9% of Diplomates reviewed by Professionalism Committee annually
- Only 0.09% lose certification 50% of these are restored
- Most common issues: Prescribing controlled substance
 Sexual misconduct

 - · Personal substance use





2024 ABMS Standards for Continuing Certification

How is ABFM Meeting ABMS Standards?



- Longitudinal assessment as exam option
- Incorporated feedback into self-assessment and exam for learning opportunities
- Integration of activities to reduce burden
- Engage Diplomates in ongoing process improvement

New - Assess Diplomates at an interval no longer than five years to retain each certificate.





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Г	Why Change?
	To meet the American Board of Medical Specialties' Standards for Continuing Certification of assessing physicians in more frequent intervals
	To help maintain awareness of increasingly rapid medical advances and changes in practice guidelines.
	Simplify the continuous certification process so that is more flexible and convenient for you.

Certification 2025 - The 5-Year Cycle

Beginning in 2025, longitudinal assessment will be at the core: you will never need to take the one-day exam again, unless you want to!

- Existing 10-year commitments will be honored
- Other activities will continue, but with more time to complete (5 years). Choose the activities most relevant to your practice.
- Check your ABFM portfolio to see your schedule is or if you have questions.
- Fees will remain the same in 2025 (and for as long as we can!)





Penefits of the 5-Year Cycle Never take the one-day exam to maintain your certification (unless you want to). The option to answer quarterly exam questions (or opt for the traditional, one-day exam). More time and flexibility to complete certification activity requirements. Five years versus three years. Fifth year off for Diplomates who complete all requirements in four years. No changes to annual fees or ABFM Professionalism Guidelines in 2025.



Cost of Certification

Your Annual \$200 Certification Fee Covers:

- Your exam (with no exam administration fee).
- All ABFM activities including the National Journal Club.
- One free retake if your first exam attempt was unsuccessful.
- → ABFM fees have not increased since 2008.
